Rising 3rd Grade-Pizza Slice Book Report

Students will read a book of their choice. After reading the book of their choice, students will create a pizza slice book report on construction paper or cardboard no smaller than 8 inches. The slices should be labeled as follows:

Slice 1: Title & Author

What is the title and author of the story?

Slice 2: Compare Characters

Select two characters. How are they alike and how are they different?

Slice 3: Setting

Where does the story take place the most?

Slice 4: Prediction

What do think would happen next?

Slice 5: Alternative Ending

What is a different way the story could end?

Slice 6: Summary

What happened in the story? Write 3-4 sentences that tell what happened in the story.
